

CLEANING SERVICE STANDARD

Trident will visit this site on a regular basis . The timetable will be displayed on site notice boards. Here are standards that are set for the completion of these works:

- Floors and stairs will be swept, mopped or vacuumed. Please take care if the floors are wet. Floors will not be washed if there is a possibility they will freeze because of cold weather.
- 2 General surfaces such as banisters, handrails and skirting boards will be dusted or washed down.
- 3 Cobwebs from ceilings, walls and light fittings will be removed.
- A Mats and mat wells will be swept and deodorised.
- 5 Internal windows and glass that are accessible in the communal areas will be cleaned weekly.
- 6 Communal bin areas will be swept out and disinfected.
- 7 The block will be checked for repairs, damage or vandalism and these will be reported to the Homes Maintenance team.
- Litter will be cleared from inside and outside the block.
 We only clean the communal areas, not inside your homes.











GROUNDS SERVICE STANDARD

Trident will visit this site on a regular basis. Teams will work on weekends to keep on top of schedules that can't be met. Here are the standards that are set for the completion of these works:

- 1 The contractor must remove and dispose of all debris and grass clippings after every site visit.
- 2 The contractor must wear protective clothing and use the machines safely, to prevent harm to the operator or any people nearby.
- **3** Hedges are to be maintained on both sides so they do not grow over pavements or roads so people and cars can get through.
- 4 Trim back all plant growth overhanging onto paths/drives or preventing light getting into the property.
- 5 All planted beds should be kept practically weed free (90% or more) throughout the year.
- 6 We will carry out an annual site assessment and make any improvements to bring the estates back up to standard.
- 7 No work will be done before 8am Monday to Saturday, or on Saturday afternoons. No work will be done on a Sunday.
- 8 Work will not take place if the weather is bad (e.g rain, snow, high winds).







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WINDOW CLEANING STANDARD

Window cleaning works will be carried out by Arrow Cleaning Services Here are standards that are set for the completion of these works:

Cleaning shall be undertaking using clean, fresh water so that after cleaning all windows, frames, heads, cills, panels, windows fixtures, fittings and window furniture are to be clean, clear, free of loose dust, soilage, stains, cobwebs etc leaving smear free windows.

Windows will be cleaned once every two months on a Tuesday designated to your building.
